













INFORMATION for GROUP RESERVATIONS

RESERVATION:

Please make a written reservation for your group visit at tours@stiftmelk.at

Your group will be booked at the desired or the next possible time slot. You will receive a confirmation for your reservation with a tour code (= reservation number).

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS:

Tour leader and driver get free entrance (ID card necessary).

CANCELLATION:

Cancellations are free of charge within 72 hours of your scheduled arrival (daily until 4.00 pm). For a later cancelation there is a surcharge of € 50.00.

In case of a no-show there is a cancellation surcharge of € 100.00.

PAYMENT:

Payment is possible in cash or with EC or credit card on location.

Payment by bank transfer is only possible, if you have a voucher contract with Melk Abbey. Bank charges for a foreign bank transfer must be paid by the voucher client. In case of default in payment the voucher contract will immediately be terminated.

GROUP SIZE:

Max. 45 persons per guided abbey tour.

SCHEDULED TIME for guided tour:

We politely request that your group is ready at the confirmed time for your visit which is the start of the tour. Only after registration of the group at the information counter, and ticket purchase, can the guided tour begin. If you are unable to begin at the scheduled time, please inform the reservation team (+43 2752 555 232). If a group is late, we will postpone the guided tour for the next possible time slot, which means that waiting times and delays may be unavoidable. Be aware that on very busy days with many visitors, unavoidable delays may also occur at the entrance of the museum. Be assured that in all these situations we always make an effort to act in the best interest of all our guests.


VISITORS' PARKING LOT:



ABBEY VISIT

A visit inside takes you up the Imperial Staircase to the Imperial Corridor, abbey museum, Marble Hall, balcony, library, abbey church, and offers an overall impression of this exquisite cultural ensemble.

MINERAL COLLECTION

The former Abbot's Library houses a mineral collection that dates back to the 18th century.

SPECIAL EXHIBITIONS

The special exhibitions – Leave and Stay I Salir y Quedarse by MACON in the Columned Hall and Restoration and Life II in the arcade – complete the extensive cultural program.

NORTHERN BASTION & WACHAU LAB

At the portal, between the abbey buildings and the abbey park, the Northern Bastion is waiting to be discovered. From the terrace visitors can enjoy a beautiful view of the town of Melk and the abbey grounds, including the park. The Wachau Lab with the special exhibition one-way planet can be found on the first floor. On the ground floor the abbey shop offers a variety of exclusive products.

ABBEY PARK & GARDEN PAVILION

The unique park grounds are a symbiosis of architecture, nature and spirit. The Baroque garden pavilion with its exotic frescoes by Johann Wenzel Bergl, the Oriental Garden with its view of the Danube valley, the meditative Saint Benedict's Path, the Paradise Garden and many other areas promise delightful amazement as well as recreation and rest.
