**GUIDED TOUR OF MELK ABBEY**

The guided tour begins with the Prelate's Courtyard and takes guests up the Imperial Staircase, into the Imperial Corridor and former Imperial guest rooms where the Melk Abbey museum is located.

The exhibition *The Path from Yesterday to Today* features the highlights of Melk Abbey's history, its art treasures, as well as its current tasks and activities.

This is followed by the Marble Hall and the grand balcony (replacement bridge due to restoration work from March to October) which provides a breathtaking view of the town of Melk and the Danube Valley landscape below. The guided tour ends with the library.

Next, guests can go down into the abbey church, a masterpiece of high Baroque architecture, and individually visit the church at their leisure after the guided tour.

The Northern Bastion, the abbey park with its Baroque pavilion (April to October), and garden complex complete the visit of this stunning cultural ensemble.

### ABBEY VISIT

A visit inside takes you up the Imperial Staircase to the Imperial Corridor, abbey museum, Marble Hall, balcony (replacement bridge due to restoration work from March to October\*), library, and abbey church, and offers an overall impression of this wonderful cultural ensemble.

### NORTHERN BASTION & WACHAU LAB

At the portal, between the abbey buildings and the abbey park, the Northern Bastion is waiting to be discovered. From the terrace guests can enjoy a beautiful view over the town of Melk and the abbey grounds, including the park. The Wachau Lab with the special exhibition *YOUth* can be found on the first floor. On the ground floor the abbey shop offers a variety of exclusive products.

### ABBEY PARK & GARDEN PAVILION

The unique park grounds are a symbiosis of architecture, nature and spirit. The Baroque garden pavilion with its exotic frescoes by Johann Wenzel Bergl, the Oriental Garden with its view of the Danube valley, the Paradise Garden, the meditative Saint Benedict's Path, and many other areas promise delightful amazement as well as recreation and rest.
